This is a perfect time for you to become a Citizen Archivist for the National Archives. Most historical records were handwritten and cannot be transcribed into the archives until entered digitally, but the Archives cannot do it all on their own. They have a wonderful program that you can become a part of by going to citizen-archivist">www.archives.gov>citizen-archivist or google "Get started Transcribing". The subjects are varied and many, such as:

Records of enemy submarines sunk in WWII Disbarred Attorneys and their misdeeds Letters from WWII soldiers

Certificates of Registry for Livestock If you can think of a subject, I'm sure it is on the list. Just think, this will get your name in the National Archives forever as a contributing archivist.

Boost your Immune System

Your immune system defends you against the viruses that cause colds and flu.

Donating IRA Funds to a charity in 2021

If you are 70 1/2 and above and are required to take your RMD you can <u>rollover</u> IRA funds as a donation. Retirees can give up to \$100,000 to charity tax-free from an IRA anytime during the year and have it count as their required minimum distribution for the year. The money isn't included in your adjusted gross income.

Ask your IRA administrator and the charity (such as SCAS) about making a direct transfer, or you can have the IRA administrator send a check from your account to the charity.


AmazonSmile is a simple way


