

Proof of COVID-19 vaccination by businesses and employers increases. The Virginia Department of Health has announced that QR (quick response) codes are now available. Virginia is now the fifth U.S. state to adopt the SMART Health format for QR codes, empowering individuals with verifiable copies of their vaccination records. Visit vaccinate.virginia.gov to obtain your free vaccination record with QR code, to be saved to a phone gallery or printed on paper.

# Fairfax County Passes Tax on Plastic Bags at Checkout

A five-cent tax on disposable plastic shopping bags provided by retailers in grocery stores, convenience stores, and drugstores, starts Jan. 1, 2022.

It was adopted on Sept. 14 by the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors. Arlington County and the City of Alexandria have taken the same steps to reduce the negative environmental impacts of single-use plastic bags and reduce the number of plastic bags littering our roads and local waterways.

Revenue will be allocated toward programs such as environmental cleanup, pollution and litter mitigation, and educational programs.

## Drug Takeback

Unneeded and expired medications can be dropped off any time at the collection box in the Mason District Government Center on Columbia Pike in Annandale.

The goal is to prevent overdose deaths caused by the misuse of prescription drugs. According to the DEA, drug addicts often raid the medicine cabinets of family and friends. So get rid of unneeded medications.

### Free Entrance to National Parks in 2022

The US National Park Service is hosting 6 fee-free days in 2022 and <u>Great Falls Park</u>. Visit Northern Virginia area parks like <u>Shenandoah National Park</u>

Usage fees are waived at National Parks on these 6 days in 2022:

January 17, Martin Luther King Jr. Day April 16, First Day of National Park Week August 4, Great American Outdoors Act anniversary

August 25, National Park Service Birthday September 24, National Public Lands Day November 11, Veterans Day

So put on your walking shoes and get out into the fresh air and take a walk.
