Thrive At Home



Pasta al Limone



Pasta al limone, a simple Italian pasta dish that only requires pasta, lemons (the zest and juice), butter and some block Parmigiano-Reggiano cheese.

Boil salty water and add some spaghetti. While the pasta is cooking, melt some butter in a skillet and stir in some lemon zest. Remove the skillet from the heat, then add in your pasta when it's about a minute shy of al dente (reserve about a cup of pasta water). Add the water to the lemony, buttery pasta and stir over high heat until the sauce is creamy.

Stir in some lemon juice and cook for about a minute, then remove the skillet from the heat and add a generous amount of freshly grated Parmesan. Stir, working from the center of the skillet, until the sauce is smooth and creamy. That's it!

FOOD ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR OLDER **ADULTS**

Apply for Virginia's Senior Farmers Market Program if you're 60+, a Virginia resident, and earn \$2,413/month (for 1 person) or less or (\$3,261 for two-income households). You may be eligible for the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP).

Eligible residents get a one-time \$50 electronic benefit to purchase fruits and vegetables at a local farmers market through Nov. 30.

Senior Cool Care Program

Cooling Assistance is a program designed to help keep vulnerable Fairfax County residents cool during the summer months. To be eligible, at least one household member must be: 60 or older, 5 or younger, or disabled according to Social Security, Medicaid or 100% Veteran's Administration.

Cooling assistance can help with:

- Payment of electric bills to operate cooling equipment.
- Payment of security deposits for electricity to operate cooling equipment for accounts in danger of being disconnected or when a deposit is needed to begin service.
- Repair of a central air conditioning system or heat pump.
- Purchase of a whole-house fan, including ceiling or attic fans when there is no other working cooling equipment in the home.
- Purchase and installation, or self-pick-up, of one air conditioning unit (window or portable) for households when there is no other working cooling equipment in the home.

If you're 60 or older, you may also be eligible for a fan or air conditioning unit through the Senior Cool Care Program.
